ORDINANCE No. 186852 As Amended

*Authorize a contract with HDR Engineering Inc. for the Right of Way Project and Pavement Coordination project in the amount of \$250,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) is the steward of the Right-Of-Way and maintains the City's streets.
- 2. Both public and private utilities are placed within the Right-Of-Way underneath the street and utilities need to access their facilities to properly maintain them, repair them, or make alterations.
- 3. Many times streets are cut to access utilities reducing the useful life of the pavement and PBOT already faces a significant maintenance backlog.
- 4. PBOT sought and was awarded a grant from the Mayor's Innovation Fund to better coordinate projects within the Right-Of-Way.
- 5. The primary objectives for this project are to identify opportunities to reduce project costs for both PBOT and its partners through better coordination of work in the Right-Of-Way, better maintenance of City streets, and to establish protocols for coordination.
- 6. PBOT issued an RFP to solicit proposals for consultant services to determine cost saving opportunities, best practices for protocols in the Right-Of-Way, and technology recommendations to realize cost savings.
- 7. Through a competitive process, HDR Engineering, Inc. was selected.
- 8. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is high as the cost for consultant services has been negotiated.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge and is hereby authorized to execute a contract with HDR Engineering, Inc. for the Right of Way Project and Pavement Coordination project, in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because both the consultant and PBOT are ready to begin work on the project; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
