

ORDINANCE No.

186859

Amend an agreement with Volunteers of America to increase compensation not to exceed \$20,000 to assist victims and survivors of domestic violence (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 32000612)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Police Bureau responds to many calls involving domestic violence.
2. Victims of domestic violence frequently feel isolated with nowhere to turn for help and support.
3. Volunteers of America (VOA) provides resources, support, and assistance to victims, survivors, and children of domestic violence.
4. VOA provides two advocates for victims of domestic violence where weapons or a threat of weapons are used.
5. The contractor has provided these services for the bureau for over a decade without any compensation increase.
6. The Police Bureau wishes to increase the contract funding by \$20,000 for the current fiscal year.
7. This increase will align the City's domestic violence advocacy program support funding with the funding provided by the County for similar services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
