ORDINANCE No. 186860

Amend an agreement with Catholic Charities/El Programa Hispano to increase compensation not to exceed \$10,000 to assist victims and survivors of domestic violence (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 32000481)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Police Bureau responds to many calls involving domestic violence.
- 2. Victims of domestic violence frequently feel isolated with nowhere to turn for help and support.
- 3. Catholic Charities/El Programa Hispano provides resources, support, and assistance to victims, survivors, and children of domestic violence.
- 4. Catholic Charities/El Programa Hispano provides an advocate for victims of domestic violence where weapons or a threat of weapons are used.
- 5. The contractor has provided these services for the bureau for over a decade without any compensation increase.
- 6. The Police Bureau wishes to increase the contract funding by \$10,000 for the current fiscal year using existing bureau funds.
- 7. This increase will align the City's domestic violence advocacy compensation with the funding provided by the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an amendment substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit B.
