TO THE COUNCIL:

The Chief Procurement Officer has advertised and received bids for Bid Number 117104 for the SW Ventilation & Capacity Improvements project for the Bureau of Environmental Services, with a project construction estimate of \$2,700,000.00. The Bureau of Environmental Services rated the project estimate confidence level as Optimal.

Bids were opened on August 28, 2014, and four (4) bids were received. The low bid of Moore Excavation, Inc. was deemed responsive to the requirements of the solicitation, and it is recommended that their bid be accepted at the unit price quoted in their bid for a total estimated amount of \$3,458,479.00.

The Bureau of Environmental Services along with Procurement Services, identified thirteen (13) Divisions of Work as potential M/W/ESB subcontracting opportunities for this project resulting in \$653,321.06 awarded to subcontractors.

Further, it is also recommended that a two (2) year Maintenance/Warranty Bond for 20% of the final contract amount be furnished by the Contractor before final payment is released.

The bid sureties of the remaining bidders should be returned immediately in compliance with Section 5.34.410D of the City Code.
