- 5.) Familiarity with the Portland Police Bureau and how it operates.
- 6.) Familiarity with past history of police and community relations, as well as knowledge about recent events that led up to the DOJ lawsuit.

I am quite sure there are individuals who have **all six** of these qualifications. If none of the present three candidates does, then City Council should open up the process to search for and recruit a COCL person who will be able to **fully** accomplish this important job.
