

## ORDINANCE NO. 186863

\*Authorize application to ArtPlace America for a grant in the amount of \$160,000 for the Foster Placemaking Project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The ArtPlace National Grants Program provides \$10 million in creative placemaking projects. Grant funding is awarded on a competitive basis for projects that have significant potential to strengthen social, physical, and economic conditions in their communities.
2. ArtPlace America awards between \$50,000-\$500,000 to organizations, initiatives and communities of all sizes.
3. The Portland Bureau of Transportation is requesting \$160,000 to implement streetscape enhancements and place-making activities for Foster Road, such as installation of street seats, art bike racks, and activating underutilized alleyways and non-critical roadways for community and commercial purposes.
4. The 2003 Foster Road Transportation and Streetscape Plan calls for streetscape enhancements.
5. The Foster Placemaking Project will build upon the \$5.25 million investment in safety improvements built through the Foster Streetscape Project.
6. ArtPlace grant applications are due November 3, 2014.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to make application to ArtPlace America for a grant in the amount of \$160,000.
- b. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Commissioner-in-Charge's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the ArtPlace America grant applications are due no later than November 3, 2014; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
