ORDINANCE No. 186865

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Environmental Quality to conduct environmental investigation and sampling at the former Oaks Bottom Landfill and to accept funding from the State Solid Waste Orphan Site Account for a portion of the investigation. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The former Oaks Bottom Landfill was operated by the City as a solid waste landfill. The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) has determined that additional investigation is necessary to fully characterize the potential for the release of hazardous substances from the former Landfill
- 2. The former Landfill is owned by the Bureau of Parks and Recreation; investigation activities at the site have been managed by the Bureau of Environmental Services (BES). DEQ, Parks and BES have agreed upon a scope of work for the investigation.
- 3. Funds to support this investigation are available in the Environmental Remediation Fund 608000 using cost center ESPP0000012. DEQ will reimburse the Fund up to \$100,000 for allowable costs upon receipt of documentation after completion of the investigation.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Director of the Bureau of Environmental Services is authorized to execute a Intergovernmental Agreement with DEQ, in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A to this ordinance, and to execute any amendments thereto.
- Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the Intergovernmental Agreement must be signed in order conduct investigation activities and submit documentation to DEQ for reimbursement of authorized expenses; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
