ORDINANCE No. 186869

*Authorize contract with Providence Health & Services for an amount not to exceed \$500,000 for post offer of employment medical examination and physical capacity testing services. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City requires that job offers for certain classifications be made contingent on the candidate successfully completing a medical examination and/or a physical capacity test conducted by a qualified, licensed medical provider.
- 2. In order to ensure this program is comprehensive, cost-effective and meets the City's needs, this physical examination and medical surveillance program is administered by the Bureau of Human Resources.
- 3. The City issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for post offer of employment medical examination and physical capacity testing services.
- 4. The City received two proposals in response to Category I of RFP Number BHR014 for post offer of employment medical exams. Neither organization is state certified as a M/W/ESB firm.
- 5. Providence Health & Services received the highest score from the selection committee and was determined to be the organization best able to meet the City's medical examination requirements.
- 6. The City wishes to enter into a five-year contract, which may be extended for five additional years, with Providence Health & Services for an amount not to exceed \$500,000 to provide post offer of employment medical and physical examination services.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Providence Health & Services in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants in support of this contract.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists, as the current contract to provide post offer of employment medical examinations expires November 14, 2014 and an interruption to this program would result in Bureaus being unable to hire new employees in the impacted classifications; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
