ORDINANCE No. 186872

* Accept a grant in the amount of \$699,464 and appropriate \$300,000 for FY 2014-15 from the United States Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance FY 2013 Smart Policing Initiative Program to fund, in partnership with a research partner, the evaluation of the impact of patrol frequency and patrol timing on crime and service calls to support improving the efficiency of patrol methods (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Police Bureau applied to United States Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs (OJP), Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) for a grant in the amount of \$699,464 for the FY 2013 Smart Policing Initiative Program on April 22, 2013;
- 2. The Smart Policing Initiative seeks to build upon the concepts of offender-based and place-based policing and broaden the knowledge of effective policing strategies. This initiative addresses the need for effective policing, which requires a tightly focused, collaborative approach that is measureable, based on sound, detailed analysis and includes policies and procedures for accountability;
- 3. The Office of Justice Programs has notified the City that it will award a grant for the FY 2013 Smart Policing Initiative Program to the Police Bureau in the amount of \$699,464;
- 4. The Office of Justice Programs will reimburse the City for personnel and program expenses not to exceed \$699,464;
- 5. The grant period is October 1, 2014, through September 30, 2017. No match is required for this grant; and
- 6. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from OJP.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City a grant from DOJ OJP BJA for the FY 2013 Smart Policing Initiative Program in the amount of \$699,464.
- b. The FY 2014-15 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund - 217
Business Area - PL
Bureau Program Expenses - \$300,000

- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Chief of the Police Bureau of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City any subsequent modifications by OJP for the FY 2013 Smart Policing Initiative Program, #2014-WY-BX-0004, provided such modifications do not increase the City's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because a delay would jeopardize the awarding of the grant funds from OJP. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
