Mayor and Commissioners,

I am pleased to present for your consideration the report from Stern Consulting, LLC, assessing the feasibility of implementing 311 at the City and making recommendations regarding that implementation.

As you know, 311 is a single, easy-to-remember telephone number that provides seamless access to government services and information. 311 is more than just a phone number; it is a sophisticated software system that provides a database of information and tracks and routes services requests to the appropriate bureaus. More than 80 jurisdictions nationally have added 311 and have found that it is a powerful tool for improving constituent engagement and customer service.


Council allocated funding in the Fiscal Year 2012-13 budget to hire a consultant to prepare a 311 feasibility study for the City. In July 2014, the Bureau of Emergency Communications contracted with Stern Consulting LLC to conduct the study and prepare a report, which is attached as an exhibit. The report recommends that Portland should implement 311 to improve its customer service, outlines a plan for rolling out the system, and provides estimated costs and return on investment over time.
