## CONCEPT 1: Retain Water in Reservoirs

Mt. Tabor – Community Discussion Options

**Description:** Maintain reservoirs filled with water

**Cost:** \$90,000 per year to fill, drain, clean, and refill all three reservoirs. Up to \$600,000 additional funding for capital improvements for circulation to address water quality





CONCEPT 2: Drain Water from Reservoirs

Mt. Tabor – Community Discussion Options

*Description:* Drain reservoirs of water and leave empty

*Cost:* Cost for maintenance is not currently available





### CONCEPT 3: Implement Gustafson Guthrie Nichol Design (2003 Competition)

Mt. Tabor – Community Discussion Options

**Description:** Maintain water in reservoirs, add park improvements (water features, pathways, plantings, water garden)

**Cost:** \$40 million (preliminary opinion of cost)
