

ORDINANCE No. 186890

*Amend Feasibility Cost Sharing Agreement with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers by \$67,000 in-kind match to finalize a feasibility study of ecosystem restoration options in the Lower Willamette River under the Water Resources Development Act (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 52070)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. On April 2003, the City entered into a feasibility cost sharing agreement with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers to evaluate ecosystem restoration options in the Lower Willamette River under the Water Resources Development Act, Ordinance 177395. The in-kind match was \$500,000.
2. Amendment 1 increased the in-kind match to \$2,000,000.
3. Amendment 2 added the Port of Portland as a co-sponsor for the study along with the City.
4. Amendment 3 increased the in-kind match to \$2,322,820. The additional \$300,000 was shared between the City and the Port of Portland.
5. This amendment increases the in-kind match to \$2,390,000.
6. Many City efforts to improve river health are underway, including those in the Bureau of Environmental Services and other City agencies.
7. Continuing this agreement with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers provides for the completion of the Feasibility Study and sets the stage to potentially obtain significant federal ecosystem restoration funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. The Commissioner of Public Works is authorized to sign an agreement with the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers for the purpose described into Section 1 in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Environmental Remediation fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because both the City and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers have work underway to finalize the feasibility study. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.





