#### 9. BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS

The Portland Police Bureau would like to apply for the FY 2015 Oregon Impact DUII HVE Overtime Enforcement Grant. During the 2013-14 grant year, the Traffic Division was able to arrest over 350 impaired drivers with the use of the grant funds. For this grant cycle, Oregon Impact will reimburse overtime at a rate of \$60.00 per hour for enforcement activities and requires that agencies receiving funds participate in two National Highway Traffic Safety Administration pre-determined high visibility enforcement events with the Oregon Association of Chiefs of Police and the Oregon State Police; Christmas 2014/New Year 2015 and Labor Day 2015.

This Ordinance gives Council's authorization to apply for an award of \$100,000. There are no legal issues or controversial issues with this legislation. No citizen participation was included in creating this legislation. This legislation does not affect current City policies.
