ORDINANCE No. 186902

Amend various sections of the Public Works Improvement Code for consistency and clarity of general language and organization cleanup (Ordinance; amend Code Chapters 3.13, 17.04, 17.32 through 17.36, 17.38 and 17.39)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services (BES) is authorized as the administrative lead on eight separate Chapters of the Portland City Code (PCC). The BES Director has adopted over 30 administrative rule documents to implement the authorities granted in these Chapters.
- 2. BES annually reviews its PCC Chapters and administrative rules to identify where minor changes are needed to enhance clarity, update incorrect cross-references, and improve consistency.
- 3. In addition, the 2014 changes conform to the new Treasury Division Cash administrative rule (FIN-6.10), include new rules for implementing the sub-meter program, and respond to requests for additional clarifying language from the City Attorney's Office.
- 4. BES conducted a public review of and comment period for the proposed 2014 BES code and administrative rule clean-up package from September 26 to October 27, 2014. Public review included notice in the Oregonian, posting information on the BES website and an offer to hold a public hearing on request. No such request was made and no public comments were received.

NOW, THEREFORE, the council directs:

- a. That the proposed amendments be made to PCC Chapters 3.13, 17.04, 17.32, 17.33, 17.34, 17.35, 17.36, 17.38 and 17.39, as outlined in Attachment A.
- b. That the Director of BES adopt the changes posted for public review to administrative rules for: BES SDCs (ENB-4.05); Line and Branch Charges (ENB-4.06); Storm Sewer and Drainage System Discharges (ENB-4.13); Clean River Rewards (ENB-4.16); Mandatory Sewer Connection (ENB-4.18); Downspout Disconnection (ENB-4.21); BES Public Works Enforcement (ENB-4.22); Extra Strength Charges (ENB-4.25); Fats, Oils, and Grease (ENB-4.26); Nonconforming Sewer (ENB-4.27), and BES Financial Assistance program administrative rules. In addition new administrative rules for the BES Sub-Meter Program will be adopted. The BES Director will adopt these administrative rule changes to coincide with the effective date of the proposed amendments to the PCC.
