Pursuant to Ordinance Number \_\_\_\_\_

This Contract was made and entered by and between Michael Willis Architects, hereinafter called Contractor, and the City of Portland, a municipal corporation of the State of Oregon, by and through its duly authorized representatives, hereinafter called City.

1. This Contract is hereby amended to change, update and memorialize the following:
  - A. The scope of work under this Contract shall include the following additional tasks:
    - i. Completion of all studies necessary for redesign of upper parking lot to accommodate the fueling station remaining at its current location; improving access between existing and new buildings; constructing stairs between two grades at the site; improving the layout of one floor of the maintenance building; and making adjustments to exterior walls to accommodate the access improvements.
    - ii. All work necessary to complete the design and to change existing permitted drawings for each work item as required.
    - iii. All coordination, all design meetings and all associated construction-related activities for the items listed above.
  - B. The Contract is amended to increase the maximum price by \$280,000. Total payment under the Contract shall not exceed \$3,504,029.50. The updated budget detail is attached as Attachment 1 to this amendment. Funding is available in the FY 2014-15 Budget and will be requested in the FY 2015-16 Budget required.
2. The amendment shall extend the Contract to align with the current construction contract for the Interstate Maintenance Facility Rehabilitation project. The revised expiration date of the Contract is now June 30, 2016.

All other terms and conditions shall remain unchanged and in full force and effect.
