ORDINANCE No. 186905

*Authorize Intergovernmental Agreement with Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District of Oregon to provide exclusion hearings. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council Finds:

- 1. The City provides administrative hearings services for exclusion programs through the City's Code Hearings Officer.
- 2. The Tri-County Metropolitan Transportation District (Tri-Met) desires to utilize the City's Code Hearings Officer to provide administrative hearings services for Tri-Met's exclusion program.
- 3. It is an appropriate and efficient use of governmental resources for the City and Tri-Met to enter into an intergovernmental agreement for the city to provide hearings services for all exclusions ordered by Tri-Met within the Tri-Met district.
- 4. Tri-met has agreed to pay the City for the cost of providing this service.
- 5. The Code Hearings Officer will maintain records for the costs of providing hearings under this agreement.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council Directs:

- a. The Auditor is authorized to sign an agreement, substantially similar with the attached Exhibit A, with Tri-Met to provide administrative hearings for all exclusions ordered by Tri-Met within the Tri-Met district.
- b. The Auditor is authorized to sign amendments to the agreement authorized by section a. above.

Section 2. The Council declares an emergency exists because of Tri-Met's need to provide timely exclusion hearings to the public; therefore, this ordinance shall be in force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
