\* Authorize contract with Cardno GS, Inc. in the total amount of \$786,935 to provide consultant services for a Facilities Conditions Assessment. (Ordinance; Contract No. 30004265)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland performs annual building inspections on many of its structures and inputs this data into Bureau specific databases. The building inspections and resulting reports identify routine or major maintenance needs. The city has determined that a more comprehensive and organized approach to these inspections is desired.
- Work under this contract will include a complete and thorough non-destructive conditions assessment of each facility identified in the contract, including grounds, architectural components, civil/structural, and mechanical/electrical building systems. Work also includes performing an analysis of the current Facilities Services work order program including discussion of industry standards and recommendations for improvement.
- 3. This contract provides for an optional seismic assessment for City Buildings.
- 4. The services were advertised under FAC030 and nine proposals were received. The selection committee reviewed and scored these proposals in accordance with PCC 5.68 and selected Cardno GS, Inc.
- 5. The City desires to enter into a PTE contract with Cardno TEC, Inc. with a not-to-exceed contract amount of \$786,935.
- 6. The M/W/ESB participation in this contract is 26%.
- 7. The Confidence Level Rating for this PTE project is Optimal.

## NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to enter into a contract with Cardno GS, Inc. for services in accordance with contract 30004265 attached hereto as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks payable to Cardno GS, Inc. when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists to avoid a delay in proceeding with the contract. Therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
