

ORDINANCE No. 186918

*Amend an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County for the Sex Buyers Accountability and Diversion Program (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30002122)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The City of Portland (City) and Multnomah County (County) are committed to addressing the problem of prostitution in the city.
2. The Sex Buyers Accountability and Diversion Program (SBAD) offers education for persons arrested for solicitation of prostitution about the legal, social, and health ramifications of the commercial sex trade.
3. The County contracts with Lifeworks Northwest to provide assistance in the design, development and implementation of the SBAD program.
4. Sexaholics Anonymous is a new additional curriculum provider for the SBAD program.
5. This amendment will add Sexaholics Anonymous to the list of SBAD curriculum providers.
6. The current term of this agreement will expire on December 31, 2014.
7. This amendment will extend the term of the intergovernmental agreement through December 31, 2016.
8. Time is of the essence because the current agreement will expire on December 31, 2014. For this reason it is in the interest of the City that this be an emergency Ordinance to be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to amend the intergovernmental agreement in a form substantially in accordance with the agreement attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because undue delay will result in the expiration of the SBAD IGA. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
