ORDINANCE NO. 186919

* Authorize application to the Oregon Department of Transportation Transportation Safety Division for a grant in the amount of \$12,000 for overtime reimbursement for enhanced speed enforcement at top speed-involved crash locations within the City during Federal Fiscal Year 2014-2015 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Portland Police Bureau would like to apply for the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) Transportation Safety Division Speed Enforcement Grant for Federal Fiscal Year 2014-15.
- 2. Portland Police Bureau officers would be reimbursed for overtime worked enhanced speed enforcement at top speed-involved crash locations within the City as determined from ODOT data.
- 3. ODOT reimburses officer overtime at a rate of \$62.76 per hour and sergeant overtime at a rate of \$70.56 per hour for enforcement activities specified toward this patrol.
- 4. ODOT requires that the project manager prepare a monthly results report and provide it to the Transportation Safety Division via email within 30 days of the end of the month.
- 5. Local match is required by matching straight-time enforcement hours at a rate of 25% of the grant amount, which will be funded by existing bureau General Fund appropriation.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to make application to the Oregon Department of Transportation Transportation Safety Division for a grant in the amount of \$12,000.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because of critical deadlines in the grant application process. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
