ORDINANCE No. 186930

* Authorize Intergovernmental Agreements with Portland Public Schools and the Centennial, David Douglas, Parkrose, Reynolds and Riverdale schools districts for use of Arts Education and Access Fund revenues. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. Arts and music are essential to a high quality, well-rounded education. Education is a top goal of the City's Portland Plan.
- 2. The voters of the City of Portland, Oregon approved ballot measure 26-146 in the November 6, 2012 general election, establishing the Arts Education and Access Income Tax and Fund to restore arts and music education and fund the arts.
- 3. The City's Revenue Division of the Bureau of Revenue and Financial Services is authorized to receive gross revenues collected as a result of the Arts Education and Access Income Tax and distribute a portion of the Net Revenues to the six school districts serving Portland students, including Portland Public Schools and the Centennial, David Douglas, Parkrose, Reynolds and Riverdale districts.
- 4. Following the initial year of collection and disbursement of the tax revenues, there are clarifications that should be made to the Intergovernmental Agreements (IGA) to provide additional clarity of the parties' responsibilities.
- 5. All six school districts have reviewed the changes and have signed the new IGA for their district.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is authorized to sign the six IGAs with each of the six school districts Portland Public Schools and the Centennial, David Douglas, Parkrose, Reynolds and Riverdale school districts – attached to this ordinance.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to provide for immediate payment from the Arts Education and Access Fund Net Revenues as provided by City Code.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in approving the agreements would cause uncertainty to the school districts and could delay disbursements of needed funds to pay for the additional arts and music teachers authorized by the voters; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
