## ORDINANCE No. 186931

\*Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$50,000 from and authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County for the East Portland Action Plan at the Office of Neighborhood Involvement (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. Office of Neighborhood Involvement applied on May 19, 2014 to Multnomah County for a grant in the amount of \$50,000 for:
  - **a.** Translating and publishing informational brochures regarding school-based health centers serving the residents of the EPAP.
  - **b.** Awarding grants of no more than FIVE THOUSAND (\$5,000.00) per grant recipient to support projects in East Portland that explicitly address at least one EPAP action item and that will engage at least one population that historically has been underrepresented in the civic decision making process.
- 2. Multnomah County has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the East Portland Action Plan Grants Programs and school-based health center brochure translation to Office of Neighborhood Involvement in the amount of \$50,000;
- 3. The grant is to support the goals of the EPAP to improve the quality of life, help foster strong community connections within East Portland, increase the area's significance, and improve equity for East Portland residents through the work of the East Portland Action Plan, East Portland Neighborhood Office (EPNO) of the City's Office of Neighborhood Involvement.

## NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Multnomah County for the East Portland Action Plan Grants Programs and school-based health center brochure translation in the amount of \$50,000 and to execute an intergovernmental agreement in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The FY 2014/2015 budget is hereby amended as follows:

c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or

- amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Director of the Office of Neighborhood Involvement of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by Multnomah County for East Portland Action Plan, award number 4400001445, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
