

## **ORDINANCE No. 186935**

Amend an Intergovernmental Agreement with Multnomah County to decrease funding by \$136,955 for transitional housing for chronic offenders identified by the Service Coordination Team (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 320004147)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The chronic recurrence of crime diminishes neighborhood livability and negatively impacts the community's perception of safety.
2. There is a causal relationship between substance abuse and the commission of crime.
3. When treatment programs are more available for those offenders with the greatest need for and potential to benefit from treatment, crime decreases.
4. Multnomah County manages a contract with Volunteers of America to provide these treatment services.
5. Supportive housing for this treatment will be moved to a different facility and managed by a different contractor. Multnomah County will now contract VOA for treatment services only.
6. The City wishes to amend the contract to decrease funding by \$136,955. The new not to exceed amount on the contract will be \$609,045.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:


- a. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to enter into an agreement substantially in accordance with the amendment attached as Exhibit A.
