ORDINANCE NO. 186939

Authorize a change order for the Powell Butte Reservoir 2, Phase 2 project at a cost of \$1,600,000 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30002100)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. A finished drinking water reservoir contains water that has been through all the treatment steps required by the federal Safe Drinking Water Act and can be delivered to the public without further treatment. Five of Portland's finished drinking water reservoirs are uncovered. Three are located at Mount Tabor Park and two are located in Washington Park.
- 2. The United States Environmental Protection Agency's Long Term 2 Enhanced Surface Water Treatment Rule ("LT2") affects uncovered finished drinking water reservoirs by requiring that water systems either cover the reservoirs or provide treatment at the outlets of the reservoirs to remove or inactivate the *Cryptosporidium* and *Giardia* protozoa, and certain viruses.
- 3. Powell Butte Reservoir 2, Phase 2 (the "Project") is one of several projects associated with the City's strategy to comply with LT2.
- 4. The Project includes construction of the second 50-million gallon reservoir, piping, and appurtenances on Powell Butte and offsite, construction of a maintenance building, caretaker house and visitor center, as well as other minor park improvements.
- 5. The Project was originally budgeted at \$138,000,000 in 2009. In 2010, the budget was reduced to \$129,000,000. In 2014, the budget was revised and is expected to be completed at an estimated cost of \$117,300,000, 15% under budget.
- 6. The Water Bureau contracted with SSC Construction, Inc. to construct the Project. The original contract amount with SSC Construction, Inc. was \$80,238,574. There have been eight change orders approved previously for a net increase in the contract amount of \$2,177,565.31. Change Order 9, substantially in the form attached hereto as Exhibit A, would increase the contract amount to \$84,016,139.31, which is 4.7% over the original contract amount.
- 7. Change Order 9 to the contract with SSC Construction, Inc. provides compensation for valve changes, relocation of a vault, work stoppage to accommodate tie-in work for Kelly Butte and Conduit 2 maintenance shutdown, additional concrete work on the reservoir, payment of a Department of Environmental Quality fine, contract time extension, modifications to contract specifications and deduction for pay item work deleted from the contract.

- 8. The total cost of Change Order 9 is \$1,600,000 with a high level for the confidence rating. Funding for Change Order 9 is included in the FY 2014-15 approved budget.
- 9. Funding of \$15,700,000 is available in the FY 2014-15 Budget. Additional funding of \$800,000 will be requested in the FY 2015-16 Budget to close out the Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Portland Water Bureau Administrator is authorized to execute, on behalf of the City, Change Order 9 in an amount not to exceed \$1,600,000 to Contract 30002100 with SSC Construction, Inc.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver checks chargeable to the Water Fund when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.
