Planning and Sustainability Commission:

Please do NOT amend the environmental zones at Terminal 6 to allow hazardous propane to be transported through the environmental zones by pipeline.

The proposed facility raises significant environmental questions.

- 1. It would be one of the largest electricity users in Portland, resulting in huge carbon dioxide emissions.
- 2. Neither Pembina nor the Port has analyzed the environmental risks associated with this facility or the transport of propane along the Columbia River by boat and rail.
- 3. The proposed facility is in the midst of valuable environmental assets: Smith and Bybee Lakes, Columbia River, and West Hayden Island.
- 4. The project would provide a meager number of jobs.
- 5. The project would shut down the waterway for several days each month.
- 6. Air quality would suffer.

Please consider these issues and don't be tempted by the promise of tax revenue.
