I oppose the proposed Pembina propane export terminal. Portland was recently awarded President Obama's Climate Action Champions award. The city's own climate goal is to reduce our carbon emissions by 80% by 2050. The Pembina proposed propane export terminal would result in over 10,000 tons of CO₂ released into the atmosphere each day. This does not include releases during production, shipping or ultimate end use of the LPG. The carbon from these emissions will not stay within the borders of the region where the propane is burned. It will affect the climate and carbon emissions around the globe.
