ORDINANCE No. 186946

*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with Home Forward for compliance and other services related to the Workforce Training and Hiring and Section 3 Programs (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council Finds:

- 1. The City has a compelling governmental interest in facilitating the full participation of all persons in the opportunities generated by the City's public works contracts, as detailed in the Portland Plan and the Social Equity Contracting Strategy previously adopted by the City Council.
- 2. City Council passed Ordinance 183019 on July 22, 2009 authorizing the execution of an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Housing Authority of Portland (HAP) to assist in performing compliance on their Workforce Training & Hiring Program (WTHP) and Section 3 program.
- 3. Home Forward (previously HAP) has expressed an interest in continuing the relationship with the City for compliance of their equity initiatives. To facilitate WTHP and Section 3 compliance, an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) has been developed between the parties.
- 4. The IGA will permit the City to continue providing training, assistance, and compliance services to Home Forward. In return, Home Forward will coordinate these programs with the City and provide funding to the City in the amount of \$50,000 annually, with a total not to exceed amount of \$250,000 for the five year period. This IGA will expire December 31, 2020.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The Chief Procurement Officer (CPO) is authorized to execute an IGA and subsequent amendments with Home Forward for the purpose described in Section 1, in a form substantially in accordance with the IGA attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The council declares that an emergency exists in order to perform continued compliance on open projects; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and in effect after its passage by council.
