The change to the contract clarifies existing language relative to the calculation of RACC’s current appropriation level (CAL) target. Based on historical data, in most cases, the RACC CAL target will grow by 4% each year. Though in some years this would represent a reduction relative to the previous contracts, over time RACC will receive larger target increases compared to City General Fund bureaus.
