

**ORDINANCE No. 186954**

\*Authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation for a Blanket Services Agreement for design review and construction inspection services to be provided by the City on an as needed basis. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. It is common for the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) to enter into an agreement with the City of Portland (COP) whenever ODOT has a project that impacts COP's facilities and requires the COP's review of ODOT's project design; and COP's inspection of ODOT's project construction. It is also common to enter into similar agreements when ODOT requests the COP to perform certain services in support of an ODOT project.
2. ODOT and COP have proposed that they enter into this Agreement to establish terms for any future non-construction related services required of COP to be addressed by individual Work Order Authorizations (WOA) rather than entering into a separate agreement each and every time.
3. ODOT and COP will sign each individual WOA before any work begins.
4. This IGA will authorize payments for WOAs up to \$500,000 combined.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to authorize an Intergovernmental Agreement with the Oregon Department of Transportation for a Blanket Services Agreement in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by this IGA; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
