

ORDINANCE NO. 186956

\* Amend subrecipient contract with JOIN for \$492,273 for housing vulnerable adults and outreach and housing placement to veterans and people experiencing homelessness in Multnomah County east of the Portland City limits. (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 32001124)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds that:

1. The Portland City Council made a new investment of City General Funds during the 2014-15 budget process to increase access to housing for priority populations identified in *A Home for Everyone: A United Community Plan to End Homelessness in Multnomah County* of \$500,000 per year. Total funds available are for an 18 month period and will not exceed \$750,000.
2. The City of Portland, acting through its Portland Housing Bureau (PHB) has been a major funder of the key strategies and services of the Plan to End Homelessness.
3. PHB facilitated a targeted Request for Proposals (RFP) in October 2014, with intent to award the identified funding for services for people experiencing homelessness or housing instability. Three service providers were selected, including JOIN.
4. The Council authorized Ordinance No. 186925 to amend an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) with Multnomah County to accept an additional \$207,273 in County general funds as revenue and to extend the scope and duration of the IGA to include an additional year of funding for a Homeless Outreach Services staffing lead and for outreach and housing placement to veterans and people experiencing homelessness in incorporated and unincorporated areas of Multnomah County East of the City limits. The ordinance found that the City intended to subcontract all work and funds associated with the IGA by amending existing Contract No. 32001124 between the City and JOIN, and that Multnomah County has authorized the City to do so.
5. PHB and JOIN desire to amend existing Contract No. 32001124 with JOIN to add \$285,000 to fund outreach/engagement and housing placement activities to vulnerable adults and families experiencing homelessness, and to add \$207,273 to fund a Homeless Outreach Services staffing lead and outreach and housing placement to veterans and people experiencing homelessness in incorporated and unincorporated areas of Multnomah County East of the City limits.
6. Funded programs and services have a demonstrated record of success and effectiveness in moving our community towards the bigger goal of ending homelessness.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs that:

- a. The Bureau Director is hereby authorized to enter into a contract amendment with JOIN in a form similar to the amendment attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Portland Housing Bureau's operating fund budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because delay in executing the contract could prevent timely delivery of contracted services. Therefore this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.




