

Reject Pembra Corporation's request to modify portions of Portland's zoning code

I urge you to reject Pembra Corporation's request to modify portions of Portland's zoning code which prohibit hazardous materials from being transported through conservation zones. The proposed zoning change sets a dangerous precedent that could allow future fossil fuel infrastructure construction throughout the region.

Pembra's proposal to build a propane pipeline across a fragile riparian area on the Columbia River and a propane export facility at the Port of Portland has environmental risks which have not been analyzed by either the Port or Pembra. The facility would be a huge consumer of electricity, which would have a measurable impact on both local and global CO2 emissions.
