186969 ORDINANCE No.

*Pay claim of Cricket Debt Counseling in the sum of \$6,200 involving the Bureau of Transportation. (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- Cricket Debt Counseling has filed a property damage claim against the City for 1. damages suffered in a motor vehicle accident involving the Bureau of Transportation on July 25, 2014.
- The claim has been investigated by Risk Management Services. The 2. investigation indicates there is risk the City may be found liable. Therefore, in order to avoid the risk of an adverse jury award, we feel it is prudent to compromise the claim at this time.
- Risk Management Services recommends the claim be compromised for the 3. total sum of \$6,200, subject to the claimant providing the City with a release in a form to be approved by the City Attorney. Risk Management has already advanced \$5,000 toward this settlement.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- The Mayor and the Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver a check a. in the amount of \$1,200 made payable to Cricket Debt Counseling. Combined with the \$5,000 already paid, the total claim settlement is \$6,200.
- Risk Management Services will execute a payment authorization in the b. amount set forth in sub-paragraph (a) above.

The Council declares that an emergency exists in order to avoid undue and costly delay in settling this claim; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
