

ORDINANCE No. 186991

*Accept a grant in the amount of \$250,000 from Oregon Department of Transportation for I-205 at NE Killingsworth SB On-Ramp project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Bureau of Transportation is acting as a partnership organization for the Colwood development with the Oregon Department of Transportation for a grant in the amount of \$250,000. The developer of an industrial site will construct a southbound on-ramp onto I-205 from NE Killingsworth to improve freight mobility and access to this industrial parcel; and
2. The Oregon Department of Transportation has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for the I-205 at NE Killingsworth SB On-ramp project to the Portland Bureau of Transportation in the amount of \$250,000; and
3. In addition to execution of this agreement, the City of Portland will ensure appropriate oversight for the project; and
4. Once the project is complete and accepted by ODOT and the City, the City will enter into a grant agreement with the developer to release the funds for the completed improvements after costs of review by ODOT and the City are subtracted.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon Department of Transportation for the I-205 at NE Killingsworth SB On-Ramp in the amount of \$250,000 and /or to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The FY 2014/2015 budget is hereby amended as follows:

GRANTS FUND

Fund 217001

Business Area – TR00

Bureau Program Expenses - \$250,000

- c. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute amendments, approved as to form by the City Attorney, to the scope of the services or the terms and conditions of this Agreement, provided the changes do not increase the City's financial risk. Increases to the grant amount must be approved by the City Council.


- d. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Commissioner-in-Charge's behalf.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay would unnecessarily delay the City's ability to perform the activities authorized by the grant; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
