

ORDINANCE No. 186996 As Amended

Authorize an agreement with Portland Streetcar, Inc. to provide a Streetcar Operator relief point (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Portland Streetcar, Inc. (PSI) agrees to provide streetcar operators with access to an "Operator Relief Room" at 1031 NW 11th Avenue, Portland, Oregon. The space will include one (1) Americans With Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant and accessible bathroom and kitchenette with potable water, refrigerator, microwave, internet, seating, flatware, cups and other appropriate kitchen items as well as one (1) 24/7 secured, private entrance.
2. The City of Portland agrees to provide weekly cleaning service for the Operator Relief area. The City will also be responsible for stocking bathroom tissue and paper towels, providing garbage and recycling services and training occupants on techniques for maintaining a clean and professional work environment.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. That the Commissioner-in-Charge is hereby authorized to enter into an Agreement with Portland Streetcar, Inc. to provide an Operator Relief Point, in a form similar to the contract attached as Exhibit A.



