Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:

Ordinance number 182542, approved on February 18, 2009, authorized the Bureau of Environmental Services to enter into a Mutual Agreement and Order with the Department of Environmental Quality and Clean Water Services. This agreement listed capital improvement projects required by the agreement along with dates for completion. This information need to be updated to conform with our revised Capital Improvement Plan and with new dates for completion.
