ORDINANCE No. 187002

Authorize four price agreements not to exceed \$500,000 each for on-call civil engineering services in support of Bureau of Environmental Services capital improvement program projects (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The Bureau of Environmental Services requires professional engineering services in support of storm and sanitary sewers, wastewater pump stations, wastewater treatment facilities, stormwater treatment facilities and drainageway improvements for projects included in the Capital Improvement Program.
- 2. The professional engineering services for these projects are normally of short duration, specific in nature and usually of relatively small dollar value.
- 3. A consultant selection process was conducted recently (RFP BES153) in accordance with Chapter 5.68 of the Code of the City of Portland.
- 4. A total of twenty-six certified M/W/ESB sub-consultants may participate on an as-needed basis. Total M/W/ESB participation for the four contracts is estimated at an aggregate of 41% utilization. Participation will be dependent on the amount and type of services required as work orders are issued.
 - 5. The contract terms are three (3) years.
- 6. The established cost is not to exceed \$500,000 each for a three-year term. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2014/2015 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Cost Center ESEN000020.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute contracts with HDR, Inc., Parametrix, and Greenworks P.C. in forms substantially similar to the agreements attached within Exhibit A to this ordinance and for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount not to exceed \$500,000 each for the three-year term.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.
