

ORDINANCE No. 187011

Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$17,850 from Oregon State Fire Marshal for hazardous materials response training (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

1. Portland Fire & Rescue (PF&R) applied to the Oregon State Fire Marshal (OSFM) for a subgrant in the amount of \$17,850 for hazardous materials response training on March 4, 2014; and
2. OSFM has notified the City of Portland that it will award a grant for hazardous materials response training to PF&R in the amount of \$17,850;

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland a grant from the Oregon State Fire Marshal for hazardous materials response training in the amount of \$17,850 and to execute an intergovernmental agreement in a form similar to the agreement attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The FY 2014/2015 budget is hereby amended as follows:



- c. The Office of Management & Finance Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. The Fire Chief of Portland Fire & Rescue of the City of Portland is authorized to accept on behalf of the City of Portland any subsequent modifications by Oregon State Fire Marshal for HMEP grant, award number OSP #: IGA-360-2014, provided such modifications do not increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk. Any modifications that increase the City of Portland's financial obligation or risk must be authorized by the Portland City Council.
