187012 ORDINANCE No.

*Amend contract with Oregon Trail Chapter American National Red Cross for an additional \$105,000 for severe weather emergency shelter (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 32001101)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds

- 1. From November 1, 2014, to March 31, 2015, the American Red Cross provides Severe Weather Emergency Warming Center overflow services for adults who are homeless (men, women, and couples) for a minimum of 150 persons.
- 2. The original Contract's scope of service was for ten nights of warming center operation. The shelter opened for the tenth night on December 1, 2014. The Contract scope of services was subsequently amended to add additional budget and five additional nights of warming center operations. Since that amendment, additional severe weather events have required severe weather warming center operations for 5 additional nights (15 total nights this winter).
- 3. Additional severe weather events are likely throughout the remainder of the winter, and additional scope of service and budget is necessary within the agreement to open the Severe Weather Emergency Warming Center in these likely events.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Bureau Director is hereby authorized to execute an amendment with the American Red Cross, Oregon Trail Chapter in a form similar to the amendment attached as Exhibit A.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Portland Housing Bureau's operating fund budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a delay in enacting this ordinance could result in decreased severe weather shelter capacity for future severe weather events, placing people experiencing homelessness at increased risk of exposure related illness or injury; therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
