

ORDINANCE NO. 187015

* Accept and appropriate a grant in the amount of \$5,177 from Oregon Impact for the 2015 Pedestrian Safety Enforcement Mini-Grant program (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Portland Police Bureau has been granted an award of \$5,176.80 from Oregon Impact for the 2015 Pedestrian Safety Enforcement (PSE) Mini-Grant program for Federal Fiscal Year 2014-15.
2. Portland Police Bureau officers would be reimbursed for overtime worked during PSE operations and diversion classes.
3. Oregon Impact reimburses officer overtime at a rate of \$62.76 per hour and sergeant overtime at a rate of \$70.56 per hour for activities specified toward this program.
4. Local match will be achieved by matching overtime hours with straight-time enforcement hours at a rate of \$38.16 per hour, which will be funded by the bureau's General Fund appropriation.

NOW THEREFORE, The Council directs:

- a. The Mayor is hereby authorized to accept a grant from Oregon Impact in the amount of \$5,176.80.
- b. The Mayor is authorized to provide such information and assurances as are required for the grant period.
- c. The OMF Grants Office is authorized to perform all administrative matters in relation to the grant application, grant agreement or amendments, requests for reimbursement from the grantor, and to submit required online grant documents on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. With the acceptance of the grant award, the FY 2014-15 budget will be amended as follows:

Bureau Program Expenses - \$5,176.80


