Dear Mr. Krochalis:

I am writing to request an extension of the Project close-out date for the above-referenced PCGA, which currently has a close-out date of December 31, 2014. TriMet requests a nine month extension to September 30, 2015.

The PCGA originally projected a revenue operations date of April 30, 2012. In March 2012, FTA approved an extension to May 31, 2013. At that time, TriMet did not request an equivalent thirteen-month extension of the close-out date. The Project opened for revenue service on September 22, 2012.

Working with FTA's national Office of Planning and Environment, TriMet expanded the Before-and-After study to include an analysis of economic development along the streetcar corridor. The "After" portion of the study is in the field data collection phase, with surveyors using an approved survey instrument. The work of documenting the field survey, developing the economic and transit analyses, and preparing the report is expected to be complete in late summer of 2015.

Thank you for your consideration of this request. At Region 10 staff's suggestion, we are entering the new closeout date in TEAM in the grant report for the quarter ending December 31st. Please contact Sandy Bradley (bradleys@trimet.org 503-962-2132) if you need additional information.
