

ORDINANCE No. 187039

*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the Killingsworth Phase II project (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Killingsworth Street Improvements Planning Project Final Report was adopted by Council in August 2003, by Resolution No. 36161. The Report included the contributions of over 1000 community members and created a streetscape concept plan, new streetlight standards, and design guidelines for North Killingsworth Street between North Interstate Avenue and Northeast Martin Luther King Jr., Boulevard.
2. Phase I-A, that included the five block faces from North Michigan to North Borthwick, was completed in July 2006. Phase I-B, included N. Interstate Avenue to North Michigan, and the I-5 overcrossing, from North Borthwick to North Commercial were completed in 2008. The phase II work to be completed this year and that will complete the entire Killingsworth Plan adopted by Portland City Council in 2003.
3. On February 11, 2015, Portland Development Commission (PDC) authorized a grant for \$3,000,000.00 for the construction of Killingsworth Phase II.
4. This project is identified in the City's Capital Improvement Program (CIP).
5. The Bureau of Transportation has funds budgeted in FY 2013-14 and proposed FY 2014-15 for construction, inspection and management of the project.
6. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimate for this project is moderate as the project scope is clearly understood and well defined.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to PBOT T00012 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because it is important to advertise this project as soon as possible to begin construction in the summer of 2015; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
