**Purpose of proposed legislation and background information:**

The purpose of this legislation is to authorize a grant application to Oregon Office of State Fire Marshal (OSFM) for a grant to pay for two separate advanced training programs for the PF&R HazMat Team and Station 24 specialty-trained land-based marine and flammable liquid program personnel.

- If PF&R receives this grant it will provide much needed advanced training for the PF&R specialty teams primarily responsible for handling hazardous materials transportation accidents and incidents.
- This training supports the City's Emergency Preparedness policies.

**Financial and budgetary impacts:**

- This is a grant application and has no direct financial or budgetary impact. If PF&R receives the award, there will be no direct financial or budgetary impact because the match is in-kind personnel costs.

**Community impacts and community involvement:**

- This is a grant application, therefore there has been no community involvement. However, should PF&R receive the grant award the entire community will benefit by having emergency response personnel trained to an advanced level for HazMat, flammable liquid and bulk storage incidents.
