

ORDINANCE No. 187046

Amend contract with Brown and Caldwell, Inc. for additional work and compensation for the SW 86th Ave Pump Station and Appurtenances Project No. E09051 for \$316,194 (Ordinance; amend Contract No. 30002215)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. The Bureau of Environment Services (BES) has need of continuing professional engineering services provided by Brown and Caldwell, Inc. for the SW 86th Avenue Pump Station and Appurtenances, Project E09051.
2. Brown and Caldwell, Inc. is providing professional engineering services as the Engineer of Record (EOR) under Contract No. 30002215, effective August 1, 2011, with an expiration date of July 31, 2016.
3. The estimated cost of this contract amendment is \$316,194. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund budget for project E09051. The level of confidence in the negotiated cost for the proposed Amendment 5 to Contract No. 30002215 is high.
4. M/W/ESB participation after the authorization of this contract amendment will be \$1,082,237, 31.72% of the amended contract amount of \$3,412,374.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner in Charge is authorized to execute a contract amendment with Brown and Caldwell, Inc. for the purpose described in Section 1, in the amount of \$316,194.
- b. The Mayor and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.


