## ORDINANCE No. 187050

\*Amend the FY 2014-15 budget appropriation schedule in the amount of \$5,947,662 for the Public Safety Radio Replacement and Fire Apparatus projects (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

## Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. On November 2, 2010 the voters of the City of Portland approved a measure (the "Measure") authorizing the City to issue \$72,400,000 in principal amount of general obligation bonds to finance the acquisition of fire engines and other emergency response vehicles that are needed to maintain existing service levels and replace aging vehicles, provide funds for replacement of the City's obsolete public safety emergency radio system, finance the construction of a fire station and related facilities and finance the construction of an emergency response center described in the ballot authorizing the bonds.
- 2. In 2011, the City issued \$25,835,000 authorized by the Measure and Ordinance No. 184502 enacted on April 6, 2011.
- 3. In 2014, the City issued \$22,670,000 authorized by the Measure and Ordinance No. 186441 enacted on January 29, 2014.
- 4. An ordinance authorizing the third and final issuance of bonds authorized in the Measure will be brought to City Council for approval in March 18, 2015.
- 5. The Public Safety Radio Replacement and Fire Apparatus projects in the Public Safety GO Bond Fund are proceeding quicker than anticipated and the projects will need appropriation, currently budgeted in fund contingency, to pay for expenses prior to passage of the Spring Budget Monitoring Process Report.
- 6. The Budget Monitoring Process Report is the formal process for bureaus to request adjustments to their budgets.
- 7. The Public Safety Radio Replacement and Fire Apparatus projects are projected to be completed within their overall project budgets.

## NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

a. The FY 2014-15 Appropriation Schedule is hereby amended as indicated below to include appropriation adjustments for the Public Safety Radio Replacement project and the Fire Apparatus project in the Public Safety GO Bond Fund.
