ORDINANCE No. 187052

* Authorize the purchase of up to nine Triple Combination Pumpers for a total not-to-exceed \$5,000,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland find ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The City of Portland passed a General Obligation Bond in November 2010 for, among other things, the purchase of fire apparatus.
- 2. Portland Fire & Rescue requires up to nine (9) triple combination pumpers to replace existing aging apparatus.
- 3. The estimated cost of these purchases is approximately \$5,000,000.
- 4. Sufficient funding resides in the 2010 General Obligation Bond for fire vehicles and emergency response infrastructure.
- 5. City of Portland Code 5.33.170 authorizes the City to participate in Interstate Cooperative Procurements for the acquisition of goods or services when source selection methods have been conducted substantially equivalent to those identified by City Code. The Houston-Galveston Area Council has conducted such a solicitation and the resulting contract with Pierce Manufacturing, Inc. allows such participation by other governmental entities.
- 6. The Confidence Level Rating for this project is High.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon Council acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's Report, Procurement Services is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract(s) and any subsequent amendments on behalf of the City for the purposes identified in Section 1, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Commissioner and Auditor are hereby authorized to draw and deliver check(s) payable to the contractor chargeable to the appropriate authorization and accounting center when demand is presented and approved by the proper authorities.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because a three percent (3%) cost increase is anticipated to become effective in April 2015. Therefore, this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
