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Salaam Karla. Thank you for your persistence, and for your patience with me. I am now done moving into City Hall, so am bound to get better at these protocol matters.

So, let's review:

What we know (please feel free to fix):

1. On March 11, 9am
2. We have 15 minutes – that can be used for 6 slots for total of 15 minutes.

I will intro Tim and his students (90 seconds); Janis will talk about PBoT resources (90 secs); Tim will intro his project (90 secs); three students will follow with presentations of 3 minutes each. Total: 13 minutes, 30 seconds.

Students will present copies of their publication "Jade Journal" to Mr. Mayor and City Commissioners.

Students will ask to have photos taken of them standing behind Commissioners.

What we still need to know:

1. Names of student presenters, they can use school contact information. A sentence summary of what they'll be presenting in front of City Council. Tim, just be general, this is for purpose of public notification of business before City Council on that morning.

Tim, it's always best to ask students to write out their talk. Three minutes (180 seconds) is 300-350 words. Ask students to focus on talking slowly, everything they say is so-so important. Take your time. It's good civic engagement practice to give your presentation to our Commissioners so we can document your families' strengths and their urgencies. And so that we can follow up.

2. I am working with our Transportation Commissioner and East Police Precinct Commander now, let's talk about our kids following up with them. Hammering nails into place.

3. Janis, you and I need to make request of Karla to be present to City Council

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
