**Facilities Services Awarded Recognition by the Energy Trust of Oregon for reducing Energy Consumption in Facilities Service owned and managed facilities.**

For the last two years, Facility Services has participated in the Energy Trust of Oregon's Strategic Energy Management (SEM) program. The purpose of the SEM program is to reduce energy usage over the long term by continually focusing on energy efficiency measures associated with routine maintenance and increasing operations performance. There are currently ten buildings in the program:

In 2014 those buildings in the SEM program saw an electricity savings of 1,310,033 kWh (8.9%) and gas savings of 1,724 therms (1.2%).

With the Continuation of the SEM program Facilities Services is looking at 2015 as a year for continuous advancement in the program by determining specific energy goals and objectives for buildings already in the program and looking forward to adding new buildings. This incentive check presented by the Energy Trust of Oregon for \$26,545 is a reflection of the dedication by Facilities Services to promote sustainability within the city and support the City's Climate Action Plan.
