Several times during the hearings, Pembina people have answered questions of safety and environmental impacts with the glib answer, "Those details will be worked out with the Port of Portland, our Landlord." Frankly, that scares me.

Pembina and their landlord had already worked out a deal behind closed doors. It would have been an accomplished fact if it had not been for the inconvenience of a zoning regulation and the necessity of bringing it out into the open before you folks.

The "Landlord" of this project is the people of our city and the Port of Portland has shown repeatedly that it does not represent us, but enjoys very cozy relations with powerful special interests like Pembina. , So I asking the Commission to represent the people of Portland and turn down the propane terminal.
