

Commissioners,

Please reject the proposed Pembina Pipeline Propane Terminal.

This terminal would be an atrociously negative addition to the city of Portland for the following reasons (and many more):

1. Although the probability is low, it is definitely possible that a BLEVE incident or other accidents causing enormous damage can happen.
2. The terminal would make Portland a target for a terrorist attack.
3. It is completely inconsistent with Portland's Climate Action Plan.
4. It is unfair to require portland drivers to pay more money for gasoline blended with ethanol to reduce emissions and then to allow a Canadian company to create huge amounts of carbon emissions with the goal to make money (for a foreign corporation) in our city.
5. An accident caused by a propane train derailing could cause huge damages to life and property as well as environmental damages.
