

ORDINANCE No. 187076

Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the construction of the Balch Consolidated Conduit Support Project No. E09017 for \$1,800,000 (Ordinance)

The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

1. Sewer pipeline work along NW 30th Avenue, NW Industrial Street, and NW 29th Avenue is necessary to prevent street flooding, eliminate groundwater infiltration into the collection system, prevent collapse, and protect the CSO tunnel from river floods.
2. The Bureau of Environmental Services requires the furnishing of materials and labor for the Balch Consolidated Conduit project.
3. The estimated cost is \$1,800,000. Level of confidence is optimal. Funds are available in the Sewer System Operating Fund, FY 2015 Budget, Bureau of Environmental Services, Cost Center, E09017.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. The Commissioner-in-Charge is authorized to execute a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the purpose described in Section 1.
- b. The Mayor and City Auditor are hereby authorized to pay for the contract from the Sewer System Operating Fund Budget.


