## ORDINANCE No. 187077

\*Authorize a contract with the lowest responsible bidder for the East Portland Rapid Flash Beacon Project (Ordinance)

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The City of Portland ordains:

Section 1. The Council finds:

- 1. The East Portland Rapid Flash Beacon Project will improve pedestrian and bicycle crossing safety and access to transit at 12 high priority locations in outer eastside Portland.
- 2. The improvement locations were identified through the East Portland In Motion Project, adopted by Council Resolution No, 36917.
- 3. In 2014, the Portland Bureau of Transportation (PBOT) received \$1,750,000 in funding from the State of Oregon to design and construct the project.
- 4. Project design is completed and now PBOT is proceeding with bidding the project for construction.
- 5. The Bureau's level of confidence in the cost estimates for this project is moderate, as plans, specifications and estimates are now completed and the project is ready for bidding.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Council directs:

- a. Upon the Council's acceptance of the Chief Procurement Officer's report recommending the lowest responsible bidder, the Chief Procurement Officer is authorized to negotiate and execute a contract, provided the contract has been approved as to form by the City Attorney's office.
- b. The Auditor to draw and deliver warrants chargeable to T00419 when demand is presented and approved by the proper authority.

Section 2. The Council declares that an emergency exists because the project is seeking to advertise for bids as soon as practicable; therefore, this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage by the Council.
